WHAT IS NECESSARY TO TAKE ONLINE SESSIONS AT KOE?

- Second, you need a headset (a device that combines a headphone with a microphone) which will allow you to talk and listen while keeping your hands free.
- Third, you must download the Adobe Connect application.
- Finally, you have to log into koeonline.net and choose the monitoring session or workshop that you want to take.

Scroll up/down: to move slowly up or down a page.

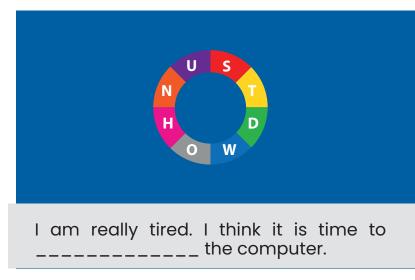

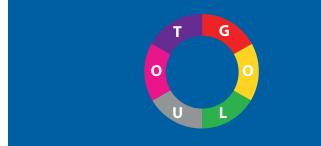

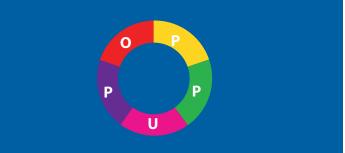
